Intel Vietnam Scholars Program

I. The SCHOLARSHIP Program

Portland State University (PSU) and Intel Products Vietnam are pleased to announce the **Intel Vietnam Study Abroad Program** for study at Portland State University in Portland, Oregon. Recipients of this scholarship will be called **Intel Vietnam Scholars**.

This program is two-fold: an excellent education at Portland State University and an engineering career with Intel in Vietnam. Intel will sponsor engineering students from select universities, currently in their third year, to complete their Bachelor of Science degrees in [Electrical](#) or [Mechanical Engineering](#) at Portland State University. The program starts in July, 2009, with an intensive academic and living orientation in Portland, Oregon. In September, 2009, Intel Vietnam Scholars will begin the first of two years of academic study at PSU. Upon graduation in June, 2011, Intel Vietnam Scholars will return to Vietnam to begin engineering careers with Intel in Ho Chi Minh City.

This Scholarship covers tuition, room & board, fees, books and miscellaneous expenses for two years of academic study and also for the summer 2009 intensive program. Scholars are responsible for their own round-trip travel to and from Portland, Oregon.

II. WHO MAY APPLY

This program is open to individuals to who are enrolled in one of the following programs at a participating university:

- Ho Chi Minh City University of Technology
 - Electrical and Electronics Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering
- Ho Chi Minh City University of Natural Science
 - Electronics and Telecommunications
- Ho Chi Minh City University of Technical Education
 - Electrical Engineering
 - Electronics Engineering
 - Mechanical Engineering
- Ho Chi Minh International University, VNU HCM
 - Electronics and Telecommunications
- Da Nang University of Technology
 - Electronics and Telecommunications
 - Mechanical Engineering
- Ha Noi University of Technology
 - Electronics and Telecommunications
 - Mechanical Engineering

In addition, applicants must meet the following minimum criteria:

- Be a full-time Vietnamese student in the third-year of study
- Have a cumulative university GPA of 7.0 or higher on a 10.0 scale for the first two years of study
- Possess strong English language skills
 - Applicants will be required to take the TOEFL examination in Vietnam, on February 14, 2009
 - A minimum TOEFL score of 525 is required
- Demonstrate strong skills in teamwork, problem solving, communication, leadership and initiative
- Be active in community and extra-curricular activities
- Not currently be an employee of any company
- Not have employment commitments after graduation

III. Selection Process

Round One

Applicants must submit the [on-line application](#) no later than 11:59 p.m. Vietnamese Standard Time on January 15, 2009. In addition, the following documents must be sent by January 15 to:

- Transcripts for the two first undergraduate years with official school stamp (in Vietnamese or notarized English copy)
- Copy of official High school record - in Vietnamese (for three years of 10th, 11th, and 12th grade)
- Copy of official score report for university entrance exam - in Vietnamese
- Any provincial and national science contest awards, honors or recognition, if applicable
- Copy of TOEFL/IELTS score, if applicable (NOTE: TOEFL or IELTS score is not required as PSU will administer a TOEFL examination in February to all candidates who meet basic requirements).

Round Two

Qualified applicants will be invited to participate in Round Two in Vietnam on February 14, 2009, during which they will demonstrate Engineering and English proficiency. Engineering technical knowledge will be demonstrated through performance on an examination administered by PSU. English proficiency will be demonstrated through performance on a PSU-administered TOEFL exam. The minimum TOEFL score required for admission is 525.

Round Three

Applicants who are successful in Round Two will be invited to participate in an Intel interview in Vietnam on March 14, 2009, designed to assess future fit in a career with Intel.

Intel Vietnam Scholars will be announced on March 27, 2009.
